## Jody Taylor - Brian Goble Memorial Music and Fine Arts Scholarship

In 2017, CUPE Local 1004 established the “Jody Taylor-Brian Goble Memorial Music and Fine Arts Scholarship” in memory of Brothers Jody Taylor and Brian Goble.

Brother Taylor worked in the horticultural field for 16 years. He was very skilled and knowledgeable, and was greatly respected because of this by the members of the Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation. He also helped many people improve their skills.

Brother Taylor was fatally injured while trimming a tree in Connaught Park on March 31, 2016. He left behind his 10-year old daughter, and is greatly missed by all who worked with or knew him. A memorial tree and bench have been dedicated to Brother Taylor in Stanley Park.

Brother Taylor was the powerhouse vocalist for ‘90s Vancouver hardcore band Strain which toured throughout Canada, the US and Europe. As well as issuing a number of singles, the band released a full-length album, “Here and Now”, in 1996.

For more than 15 years, Brian Goble worked as a Mental Health Worker for the Portland Hotel Society supporting some of Vancouver’s most vulnerable and disenfranchised citizens.

Brother Goble was a world-renowned punk rock musician and social activist. Under the pseudonym “Wimpy Roy”, he fronted the legendary Vancouver band, the “Subhumans”, and went on to join one of the most important punk bands of their time, “DOA”.

Brian dedicated his life to his art as activism and never shied away from taking a stand in support of working people, society’s less fortunate or those fighting against destructive governments, both at home and abroad.

Brian suffered a fatal heart attack while on the job in December of 2014.

CUPE Local 1004 wants to ensure that Brothers Taylor and Goble are remembered and honoured by providing this history and scholarship.

## Jody Taylor-Brian Goble Memorial Scholarship Application Form

**RE:** Scholarship Requirements

The Scholarship Applicant(s) are considered on the following Guidelines:

1. The money will be awarded to members of CUPE 1004, their spouses or children.
2. The money will be awarded annually and the date of the award established as of August each year.
3. The conditions and requirements for qualifying for the Scholarship will be clearly defined.
4. The members of the Scholarship Committee will be made known to the membership, and anyone applying for the Scholarship.
5. We will have two (2) \$1,500.00 Scholarships OR one (1) \$3,000.00 Scholarship, depending on the applications received, awarded to students studying Music or Fine Arts at an accredited post-secondary institution. If there should be no eligible applicant in any one (1) year, the money would be carried forward to the following year and no additional funds would be allocated.
6. An individual must have sufficient educational credits to enter into University, College or Technical School.
7. We will supply an application form which will be sent out to applicants.
8. The notice to apply for the Jody Taylor-Brian Goble Memorial Scholarship Award will be placed on the 1004 web site: <http://www.cupe1004.ca>.
9. The Scholarship money will be sent directly to the Institution the winner has designated with the proviso that the money should be returned to the Union if the individual does not register.
10. The schedule for the Scholarship Fund will be as follows:
  - ◆ the deadline for applications will be **noon, JULY 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019**;
  - ◆ the decision will be made in August;
  - ◆ the cheque(s) will be issued in August.
11. The 1004 Scholarship conditions for application consist of the following:
  - ◆ name, address, phone number;
  - ◆ field of study;
  - ◆ return date;
  - ◆ transcript from the last school year;
  - ◆ why the individual wants this scholarship;
  - ◆ where they are going to school;
  - ◆ association with CUPE 1004;
  - ◆ 500 word essay on Trade Unionism. (i.e., history, impact on society, pros and cons, etc.);
  - ◆ the essay may be published on the CUPE 1004 web site: <http://www.cupe1004.ca>;
  - ◆ applicants may apply for both the Wilf Greensill and Jody Taylor-Brian Goble scholarships; however applicants are only eligible to receive one scholarship;
  - ◆ previous recipients will not be considered.
